## **ANNOUNCEMENT**

### **on the Rector's scholarship in the academic year 2019/2020**

I hereby inform you that on July 15, 2019, after consultation with the USOS Team, the Vice-Rector for Student Affairs, acting on the basis of Art. 1 of Ordinance No. 161/2017/2018 of the Rector of Adam Mickiewicz University in Poznań dated January 2, 2018, regarding the scope of duties of Vice-Rectors in the 2016-2020 term, signed a schedule of activities of the procedure for submitting and examining applications for the Rector's scholarship in the academic year 2019/2020. In this way, the dates have been outlined for the individual stages of applying for a Rector's scholarship (hereinafter: the scholarship) referred to in Art. 91 of the Law of July 20, 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2018 item 1668, as amended) (hereinafter: the Law), which as of October 1, 2019 will replace the current Rector's scholarship for the best students.

Under the authority of the Rector of Adam Mickiewicz University in Poznań, I wish to inform students that the deadline for the applications to be generated, registered and printed out with attachments and submitted to the Dean's Offices has been set on October 17, 2019.

The scholarship is awarded only in response to a student request submitted to the Rector through the Committee for Scholarships. Applications will be generated from the USOSweb system, and after printing out and signing, should be submitted through Dean's Offices to the Committee along with attachments documenting the achievements indicated, by the above-mentioned date.

The system of application generation will be launched on September 23, 2019, and close on October 15, 2019.

Pursuant to Art. 91(1) of the Law, a scholarship may be awarded to a student who has demonstrated outstanding academic performance, academic or artistic achievements, or sporting achievements at least at national level. Based on Art. 91(2) of the Law, a scholarship may also be granted to a student admitted to the first year of first-cycle studies or to the first year of uniform Master's studies in the year of passing their high-school final exam, who is:

- 1) a laureate of an international contest, or a laureate or finalist of a central level contest ("*Olimpiada*") referred to in the provisions on the education system;
- 2) medalist at a sporting event meriting at least the title of Polish Champion in a given sport, referred to in sports regulations.

Pursuant to Art. 91(3) of the Law, no more than 10% of students in a given field of study may receive the scholarship. If the number of students is fewer than 10, the scholarship may be

awarded to one student. First-year students of first-cycle studies and first-year students of uniform Master's studies referred to in Art. 91(2), will not be taken into account when determining the number of students eligible to receive a Rector's scholarship.
